It is our pleasure to announce that during year 2019, all issues of volume 3 were published online on time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

All published articles of this journal are included in the indexing and abstracting coverage of CAS Source Index (CASSI), Index Copernicus, Google Scholar, Sherpa Romeo, Academic Journals Database, Genamics JournalSeek, JournalTOCs, CiteFactor, Electronic Journals Library, RefSeek, Hamdard University, EBSCO A-Z, Directory of Abstract Indexing for Journals, World Catalogue of Scientific Journals, OCLC- WorldCat, Scholarsteer, SWB online catalog, Virtual Library of Biology (vifabio), Publons, Dtu findit, Geneva Foundation for Medical Education and Research, Studies receiving funding from a funding organization that is included on the list of PMC and Research Funder Policies or authors having NIH grant were submitted to PubMed (NLM Unique ID: 101511907).

During the calendar year 2019, Journal of Insights in Neurosurgery received a total of 32 papers. During 2019 around 17 were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 4 issues of Volume 3 published during the year 2019, a total of 17 articles were published (at an average of 3 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors all around the world. A total of 30

research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 17 articles published in volume 2. Average publication period of an article was further reduced to 14-21 days.

Journal of Insights in Neurosurgery also announces its new association with HILARIS Publishers for Archiving, Journal maintenance, financial purpose and support. However the journal will be running its original website <https://neurosurgery.imedpub.com/> parallel for Editorial and review work process so as to maintain its highest standard of scientific work.

During the calendar year 2019, a total of three Editors, ten Reviewers joined the board of JINS and contributed their valuable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles, and their valuable reviewer comments will be beneficial to publish quality of article in the Journal.
